List of Naming Rights

Your loved one(s) can be honored and remembered through the generations as their names are displayed in the Fair Oaks Veterans Memorial Amphitheatre. The name of your business or organization could be seen and remembered by thousands of theatre patrons. By sponsoring key components of the theatre entrance, stage pavilion, light bridge, or other key structures within the theatre grounds, you will receive the naming rights to that special location. Review the list below to see where you would like to highlight you company or organization, or honor and remember a special group, family member, friend or leader in your community.

MAIN STAGE PAVILION----- \$250,000

All eyes are on the stage and the name of your business, organization or special family member is front and center. The center façade over the stage will be the location of a 10' wide sign featuring your designated honoree.

OVERHEAD LIGHT BRIDGE ----- \$100,000

The overhead light bridge will be an impressive structure that will soar above the audience and house the lighting and sound equipment need for the productions. Highly visible to all theatre patrons, the bridge will have ample space for the acknowledgement of your gift.

CONTROL BOOTH COMPLEX ----- \$100,000

This structure is located over the snack bar and concession booth, providing space for storage and a second story light and sound control room. The front of this impressive building will be the location of a sign displaying your individual, company or organization's name.

SNACK BAR ----- \$ 50,000

CONCESSION BOOTH ----- \$ 50,000

ALCOVE AREA ----- \$ 25,000

A very busy area visited by almost every theatre patron. Grab a snack or drink at the snack bar, purchase a souvenir or T-shirt at the concession booth and check out the cast display in the alcove, all part of the theatre experience.

REST ROOM BUILDING----- \$ 75,000

Everyone knows everyone visits here at least once in the evening. Built to accommodate our large audiences, and a major convenience and most appreciated by all. Ample room for your name to be appreciated too.

MARQUEE----- \$ 50,000

Towering over the entry to the Theatre will be a lighted, digital Marquee that will be seen not only by entering patrons, but also by local residents and shoppers strolling through the adjacent park. Seasoned theatre patrons know to visit the Marquee to inform themselves of upcoming performance schedules.

TICKET BOOTH----- \$ 25,000

Located in our entrance garden area, the ticket booth is a preview of the style and architecture of the amphitheatre remodel project. Tile roof, split-face block and generous usage of indigenous river rock echo's what's in store inside the theatre. This cute little building has plenty of room for your donor plaque.

PROFESSIONAL DANCE FLOOR----- **SOLD!----- \$ 15,000**

Take pity on our hard working dancers who now perform on a concrete floor covered with a thin buffer of plywood and masonite. We are limited to very basic lifts and dance maneuvers because we must always think of preventing injuries to the dance teams. A professional dance floor will be permanently installed in the new, enclosed main-stage building awaiting our many talented performers.

ENTRY GATES (3) ----- \$ 3,000 Each

The entry gates to the theatre grounds have been custom hand-crafted from wrought iron. The gates open up to a span of 10 feet, and serve as the entrance for thousands of theatre patrons. A brass plaque with the name of a special person, business or organization will be mounted on the top arch of the gate.

RIVER ROCK COLUMNS (6 available) ----- \$3,000 Each

Each column stand 6 feet tall, and as been made with local river rock. These beautiful testimonials to our surrounding natural environment will stand the test of time and provide an opportunity to display a plaque carrying the name of a special person, business or organization.

DONOR WALL

This project will be placed behind the seating area of the Amphitheatre. The back fence will be removed and the grass area will be landscaped with fountains, walkways and sculptures that will showcase the names of those have contributed to our beautiful theatre. This is a spectacular way to honor your special person.
